PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

Thinking of renting out your basement?

Under the Town of St. Paul's Land Use Bylaw, this is considered a secondary suite. A secondary suite means a subordinate self-contained dwelling unit located in a structure in which the principal use is a single detached dwelling or semi-detached dwelling.

A secondary suite has cooking, food preparation, sleeping and bathing facilities which are separate from those of the principal dwelling within the structure. Secondary suites also must have a separate entrance from the dwelling. This use includes conversion of basement space to a dwelling unit, or the addition of new floor space for a secondary suite to an existing dwelling.

Secondary suites are only allowed within certain Land Use Districts. An issued development permit and building permit are required before you are able to rent your suite. For further information please call the Planning & Development Department to discuss your application.
