GRASS CLIPPINGS & YARD WASTE PROGRAM

This program is for:

- Seniors (age 65+) who are unable to deliver their clippings to the Transfer Station themselves.
- Residents with a medical condition unable to deliver their clippings to the Transfer Station.

Stickers can be purchased at the Town Office at a cost of \$1.00 per sticker.

Sticker must be noticeable on each bag and a sticker must be placed on every bag with grass / yard clippings on your scheduled garbage pick up day.

Maximum of 5 bags per household, per week.

Must be a noticeable separation from household garbage when put out for pick up.

Grass clippings or yard waste must be bagged in a transparent bag only - either blue or clear garbage bags.

Bags must be no larger than 30" x 35" (76.2cm x 83.8cm x 26.7cm) fits up to 30 gallons (113.6 L) can and be no heavier than 40 lbs. (18 Kg.)

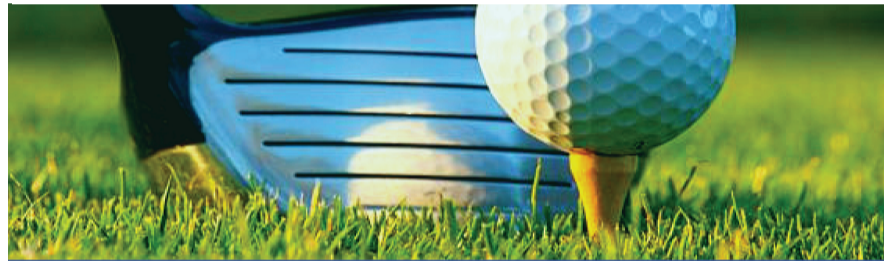
