

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

Development Permit

Check with the Planning & Developing Team to see if you require a permit for:

- excavation or stockpile; • building or an addition;
- change of use of land or building (ie. new business or change of one business to another type of business);
- change in intensity (ie. use of single family home to a business or multi-family home;
- placement of refuse or waste material on lands;
- use of land for storage or repair of motor vehicles or other machinery; • demolition or removal of a building;
- placement of an already constructed or partially constructed building (ie. sheds over 10' on one side/ mobile home);
- landscaping where grades/drainage may be affected; • decks higher than 2 feet above ground;
- home occupation (major or minor); • fence; • signs.

Wipes Clog Pipes

Issue: Public Works sector sounds alarm on stressed on wastewater infrastructure from misuse.

Key Messages:

Public Works staff across Alberta are warning that sanitary sewage systems cannot handle cleaning wipes being flushed down toilets.

Public help is needed to avoid significant disruptions.

Do not flush paper products: wipes clog pipes.

Wastewater lines and treatment plants are critical infrastructure - our behaviour matters.

Household plumbing problems are also more likely to occur due to this misuse.

All Albertans can help protect their communities' infrastructure, their families, friends and front-line workers in our communities.
