

Highlights from the Mayor



Here we are in September with another school year just beginning. And with that being said, I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone to slow down and obey posted speeds and times to allow our children to get to and from school safely. You will also notice our Town of St. Paul staff are busy in the community trying to finish projects and get ready for the upcoming Winter Season.

A great addition to Lagasse Park will be the replacement of the wooden playground structure with a new one, that will include a 75 foot zip line for youth, that is targeted for completion mid-September. Our community studies highlighted the need for outdoor recreation spaces for our residents and where those priorities fell. Be sure to watch our Facebook Page and Website for an announcement of when the equipment installation is complete and the playground is ready for use.

Our St. Paul Aquatic Centre is now closed for our annual maintenance. During the closure the pool will be drained and all filters will be removed and replaced. There will also be a deep cleaning and back-washing of all piping and equipment. The closure will begin September 6 and if all goes well reopening the end of September.

The Town Parks and Recreation Staff is now busy switching gears and preparing for the Winter Season starting with the Arenas to get back to ice operations. A target date of September 23 has been set for the opening of the Clancy Arena with an ice surface. The CAP Arena is expected to be ready for the winter season on October 14.

Also, the Tourism Centre, located at the UFO landing pad, is now closed for the season and will reopen in the Spring of 2023. But before the snow and cold temperatures are here, be sure to stop by and get in that last round of golf at the St. Paul Golf Course.
