HOW DO I KNOW IF A PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR MY PROJECT?

#### RESIDENTIAL WORK

- wire or re-wire your home
- wire to install a hot tub
- wire for air conditioning
- wire for electric vehicle charging
- wire a garage or shed
- new panel box



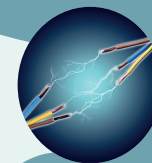
#### COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL/ INSTITUTIONAL WORK

- new service
- commercial lighting upgrades
- photovoltaics installations, off grid & grid tied



#### NEW SERVICE

- re-energize a home when power has been disconnected for more than 30 days.



#### NO PERMIT IS REQUIRED WHEN YOU...

- update light fixture, ceiling fan, or plug
- replace a breaker in a fuse panel unless its the main breaker



#### QUESTIONS?

Fees cover code related questions, inspections, & Permit Services Report (PSR) to verify that the installation is complete & up to code. Property owners & contractors are both responsible to apply for permits.
